The Purpose of This Toolkit

SIBA has created this toolkit to support our member booksellers with their displays, marketing, and efforts around promoting Banned Books Week to customers. This toolkit includes links to important resources and marketing materials from the American Library Association, ABA, ABFE, and SIBA's Peer Bookseller Resource Library.

We have also included links to book recommendations from SIBA's Southern Bookseller Review (SBR) "Decide For Yourself" feature in our SBR newsletter and social media. Decide For Yourself is an ongoing series highlighting banned and challenged books with positive reviews from SIBA booksellers. We have provided Canva templates to create your own Decide For Yourself flyers, bookmarks, shelf-talkers, and social media posts for Banned Books Week, and beyond, to bring continued attention to these important books and the issue of book bans and challenges.



How to Use This Toolkit

This toolkit is meant to be customizable for your store and designed for you to take what works for you and leave what doesn't. All marketing materials provided are in template format for you to customize. We have included ready-made social media posts that you can copy and paste, or edit to be in your own store's voice. Our "Decide for Yourself" bookmark and flyer is meant to be printed and placed into banned books on the shelves or in a display. We have also included shelf talkers for your staff to write reviews to feature banned books.

Southern Bookseller Review's "Decide for Yourself" Feature

In May of 2023, [the Southern Bookseller Review \(SBR\)](#), a newsletter and website published by SIBA, launched a feature titled "[Decide for Yourself](#)," which is a section of the newsletter dedicated to Southern bookseller reviews of books which have appeared on PEN America's [index of school book bans](#).

With over 1500 books on the list, it has been never been difficult to find books both beloved by booksellers and challenged in school districts and library systems. The first book featured in SBR's "Decide For Yourself" was [Clap When You Land](#) by Elizabeth Acevedo, which Square Books in Oxford, Mississippi calls "A beautiful story about love and loss, and how sometimes those things can be really complicated."
